IAPS Athletics Championships

SG girls once again showed their class and confidence in some fine performances in heavy rain at the Julie Rose Stadium. Spectators were perhaps surprised that events were allowed to go ahead and should be grateful to the judges and officials who stood for hours in the deluge officiating. That the programme ran (almost) to time is also testament to the quality of organisation. Performances were bound to be affected by the weather and it was no surprise that the Girls' Under 12 Long Jump was curtailed after only two rounds but not before Holly Fielder had demonstrated, with a personal best of 4.17m, that she was in a league of her own. Meanwhile, Alex Sharp and Ellie Saxby came 3rd and 4th in the hurdles, Becky Blundell did well to place 7th out of 17 in the shot putt and Emilie Knights-Toomer dominated the 100m final which she won convincingly. Arabella Saliba-Williams and Anousca de Moubray both performed creditably as our younger team members and were part of the silver-medal winning relay team. Emilie K-T picked up her second gold in the javelin (with a personal best throw) and Alex Sharp won her second bronze of the day in the same event. The girls' 800m was an eagerly anticipated event and it did not disappoint. Emily Bond (Wellesley House) won the duel against Holly Fielder but both athletes showed that they should both do extremely well in the Nationals in a few weeks' time. Both girls beat the winning times in the Under 13 and Under 14 events (by some distance). Our medallists:

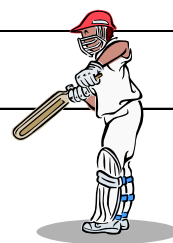
